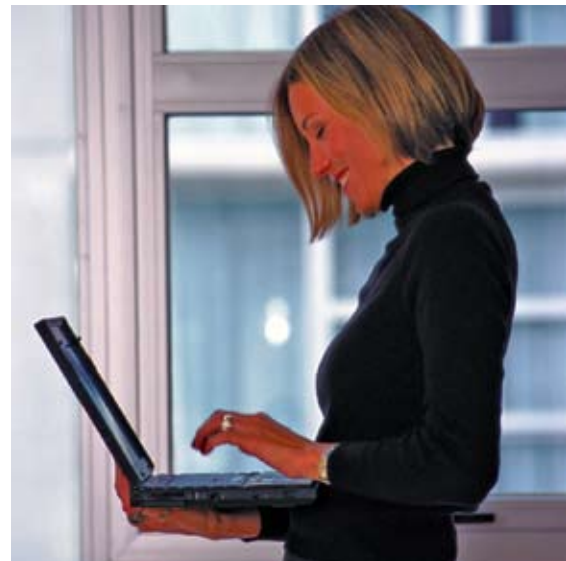

## **New Horizons Instructor Led Training with a Mentor**

*An effective and efficient approach to learning.*

A challenge faced by all organizations is how to ensure their employees with varying skill levels and learning styles receive training targeted to their individual needs and job roles. Mentored Learning solves this problem by incorporating multiple learning methods to create a focused and flexible approach to training. Employees have the ability to control the pace at which they learn and the content covered as well as determine their own training schedule.

### **The Mentored Learning Approach**

When students arrive at their center of choice, they are assigned their own networked workstation containing two monitors. This environment allows for simultaneous access to the lecture delivered via recorded audio and video, and a simulated production environment. The video format of the lecture allows the student to fully control the pace of the lecture with the ability to pause, fast forward and rewind the lecture. 
